## Right-to-work Topline

This study was conducted for the APM Research Lab via telephone by SSRS, an independent research company, via the SSRS Omnibus. Interviews were conducted from May 30 – June 3, 2018 among a nationally representative sample of 1,009 respondents age 18 and older.
